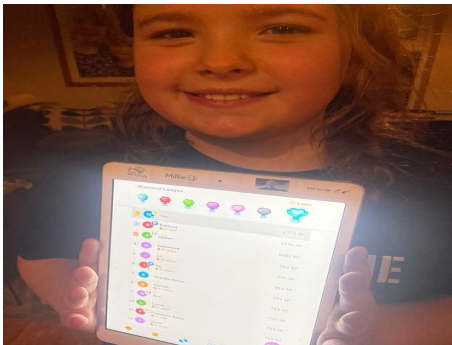
World Book Day is Thursday 6th March 2025
