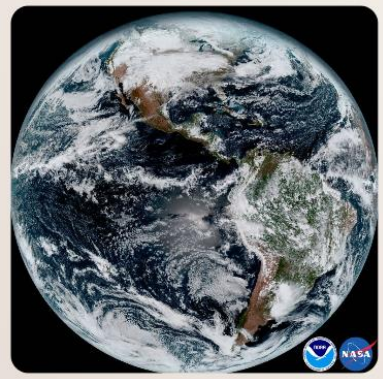

land masses.

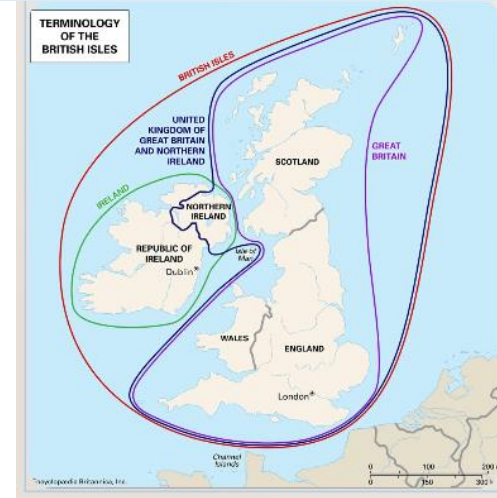


Country – Land

Wales & Northern Ireland

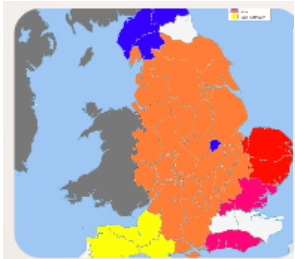
Wales is west.
