

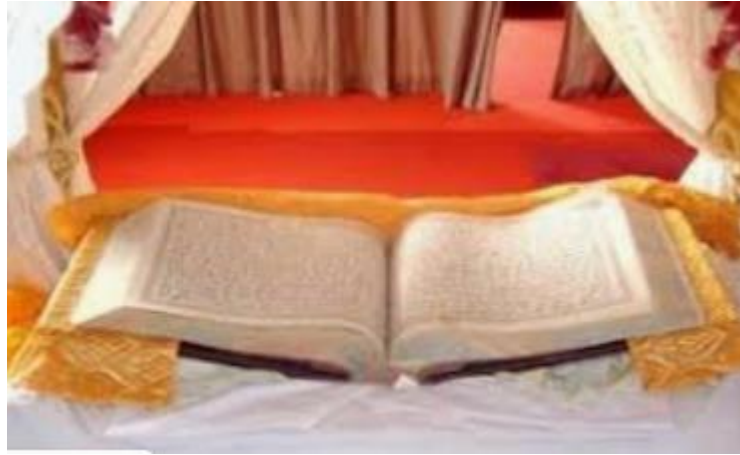
# Are Sikh Stories important today?

“Lalo’s simple bread was earned by honest work, but your cake, and all your wealth, was gained by cheating the poor.”



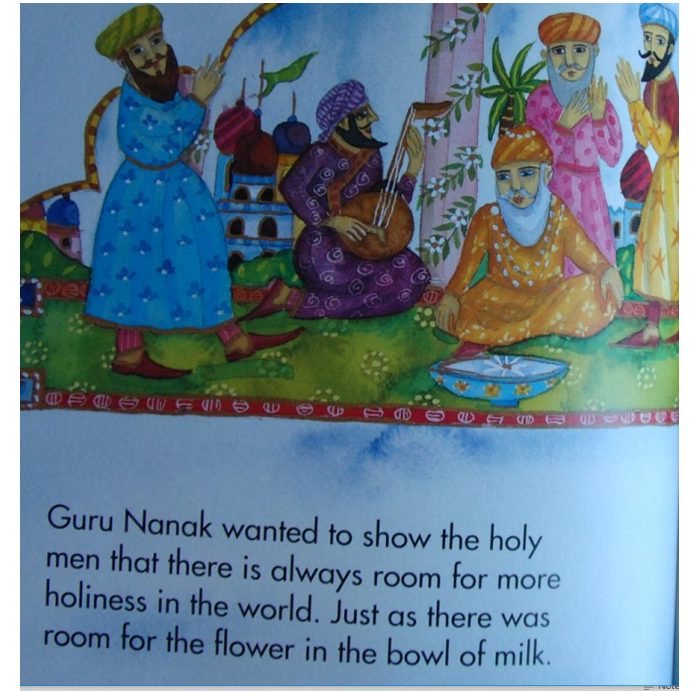
## Guru Granth Sahib – Sikh holy book
