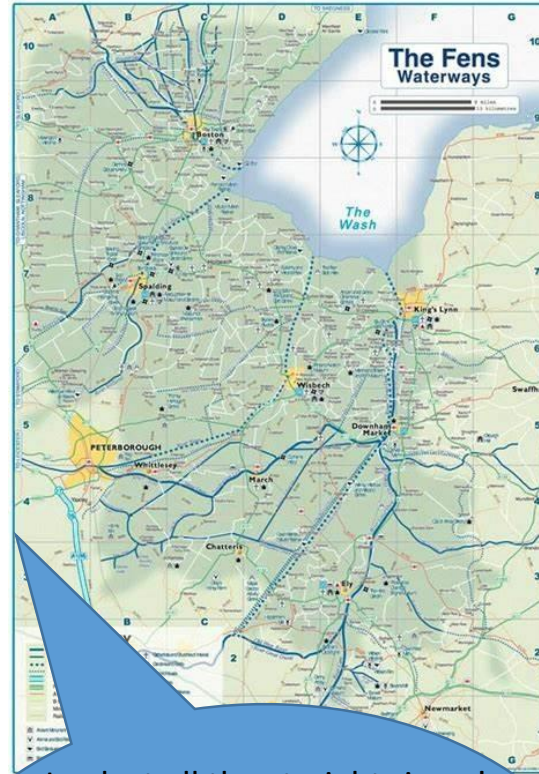
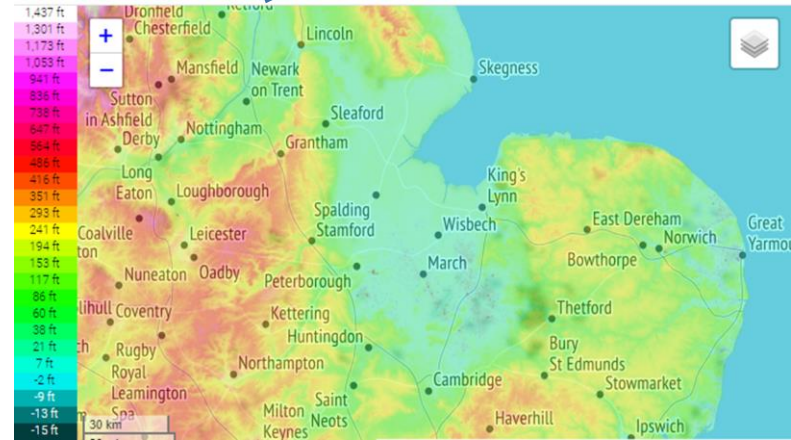


Spring 2 - Geography of East Anglia
