
Vocabulary	Definition
scale	Map scale refers to the relationship (or ratio) between distance on a map and distance on the ground. For example, on a 1cm:1km scale map, 1cm on the map equals 1km on the ground.
symbol	Cartographers (people who draw maps) use different symbols on maps to represent real features from the world. A symbol is a simple and quick to draw picture.
key	A key explains what colours and symbols mean.
population	The number of people living somewhere.
Land use	What the land is used for – housing, farming etc...
Aerial (view/photo	Pictures/photos of the earth, taken from above.

 b).1950s and c).2000s.




