


Antoine Watteau, 1684-1721 The Pilgrimage to the Isle of Cythera

Modernism	
Fauvism	Bold brushstrokes and colours often straight from the tube
Cubism	Different views of subjects in the same piece of art
De Stijl	Strict geometry of horizontal and vertical lines inspired architecture
Expressionism	Distortion of reality to allow artist to express feelings or ideas
Dadaism	Anti-War, political, often nonsensical and reflected modern world
Surrealism	Fantasy and reality in same artwork- dreamlike/ unconsious
Constructivism	Austere abstraction, belief that art should have social purpose
Post- Impressionism	Expressed emotions rather than what they actually saw

vocabular y	
style	how an artist portrays subject matter and expresses themselves
chiaroscuro	an effect of contrasted light and shadow
tint	Colour with white added
shade	Colour with black added
ground	Foundation layer to prime canvas or paper before paint is applied
underpainting	Base layer of painting (usually monochromatic – one colour)
