## **Activity Clubs**

All activity clubs for lunch time and after school will be added to Pupil Asset on the afternoon of Thursday 12th October by 1 member of the school office staff. If you are new to the school, email the office email address office@nla.eastern-mat.co.uk for a sign up email for Pupil Asset.

These clubs will start after the October half term and they will run for the advised number of weeks. There will be various clubs for different age groups on different days, children will need to be collected from the front of the school after each club. The gates will be open.

We would politely ask that you are mindful of others when booking places for your child/children. Suggesting that you book their first choice of club initially and then going back to the website a few days later to book any further choices. This will allow all parents/carers the opportunity to book places. Many thanks in advance.

### **Aspens Catering**

Our school meals are now provided by **Aspens** and are cooked on site by the kitchen team. They are providing excellent quality meals in line with the Government's nutrient and nutritional values, and they are now serving over 200 hot meals everyday, numbers reaching over 250 on Fridays. The children are enjoying the different options and flavours with a choice of desserts every day.

Menus change twice a year, so there is an Autumn/Winter menu which starts in September and a Spring/ Summer menu which starts after February half-term. Meals are served on a three-week rotation. They will also be running a Wheel of Fortune Day with voted for meals by the children from each class.

Meals for all children up until the end of Year 2 are provided free as part of the Government's Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM) programme. All meals for children in the KS2 are priced at £2.50 or means tested Free School Meals (FSM) which represents value for money. They are also providing all snacks and light meals for before and after school clubs. <u>Please remember to cancel the meal if your child is not in school</u>.

### **Attendance**

If your child is unwell and unable to come into school, there are 2 ways that you can report this.

- 1. You can fill out an absence form on the school website www.nelsonacademy.co.uk
- 2. You can call the absentee line on 01366 359 061. If you don't report the absence, the school will contact you to see why your child is off and if no contact is made, your child's absence will be marked as unauthorised.

The chart below identifies the possible amount of lost learning due to poor attendance.

Attendance during the school year equals this number of days absent. Which is approx. this many weeks absent. Which means this number of lessons missed:

90% - 19 days - 4 weeks - 100

80% - 38 days - 8 weeks - 200

70% - 57 days - 11.5 weeks - 290

Frequent absence can add up to a considerable amount of lost learning and can seriously disadvantage your child in adult life.
