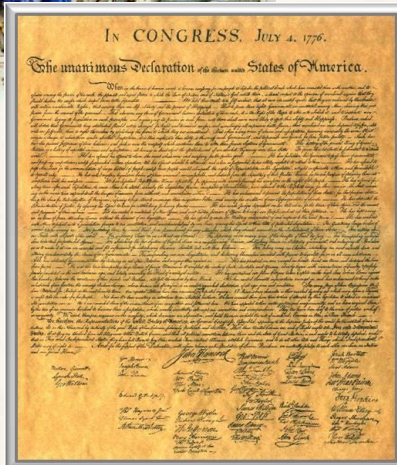

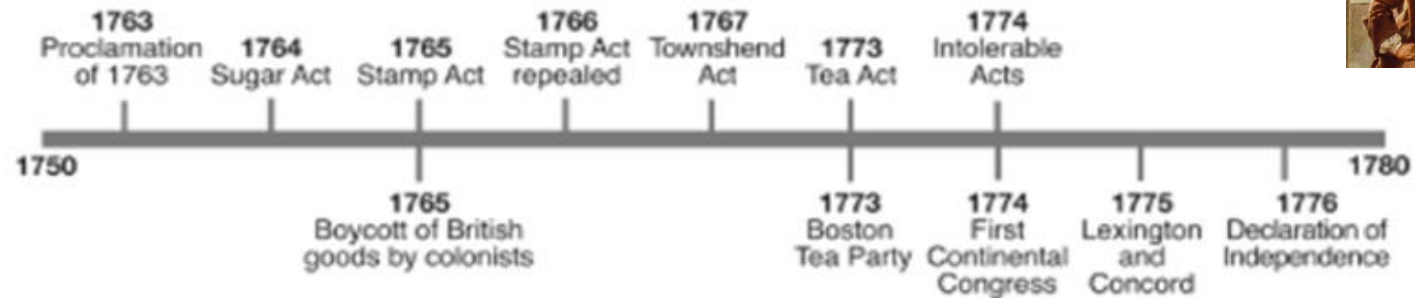


Vocabulary/ Definitions

13 Colonies: Southern, Middle and New England	13 territories settled in by the British and under British rule.
Taxation without representation:	Colonialists' slogan against being taxed by King George without representation in the parliament making the laws.
Massacre: Provocation:	Deliberate and brutal killing of a group of people. An action or speech that makes someone angry.
Revolution:	a forcible overthrow of a government or social order, in favour of a new system. The state of being free from unfair laws/ oppression.
Liberty:	Having the choice of who governs and makes laws for where you are.
