kingdom	a country, or area, ruled by a king or queen
mountain	land (made of rocks and earth) that rises up very high: mountains are higher and steeper than hills
coast	an area where land meets sea: at the coast, you could find beaches and cliffs
valley	a low area of land between hills or mountains, typically with a river or stream flowing through it
Gaelic	a Celtic language spoken in Scotland and Ireland
seasons	four different times of the year that have different weather and temperatures (spring, summer, autumn and winter)
