

### **NEURODIVERGENCE FOCUS**

#### Task Paralysis

Task paralysis is the inability to focus, concentrate or perform tasks. Typically occurs when someone is feeling overwhelmed by their environment or situation, resulting in a brain 'crash' and limited functionality. Task paralysis is common in those who have ASD and ADHD.



### Student Success

What happens next?

To vote, you will need to make a purchase within store of any value. You will receive one token per transaction and it's not necessary to purchase a carrier bag in order to receive a token. We have already begun to collect tokens in the SRB so if you get a token before voting opens, please do consider passing it onto us either via the Main School Office or via the SRB door.
