Nelson Academy SRB- SRB Outdoor Classroom- Downham Market The Specialist Resource Base would like to create an outdoor area for our students with Autism to have a space outside to learn, play and explore their sensory needs.

We are delighted to let you know that our application to the Tesco Stronger Starts has been successful and our project will be put forward to a customer vote in the local Tesco store. Voting will commence in store from the first week of October 2023 until Mid January 2024. The project with the highest number of votes across our region will receive £1,500, the second placed project £1,000, and the third placed project £500.

What happens next?

Voting will take place in the Downham Market store (PE38 9AW) To vote, you will need to make a purchase within store of any value. You will receive one token per transaction and it's not necessary to purchase a carrier bag in order to receive a token. We have already begun to collect tokens in the SRB so if you get a token before voting opens, please do consider passing it onto us either via the Main School Office or via the SRB door.
