

Total raised = £712.08




#### Message from the Principal


Dear Parents, Carers and Children,




Willow in year 1 has smashed her blue level Gymnastics Award



There will be a change on Week 2 starting on Friday 3rd May, fish cakes will change to fish fingers





## Online safety wordsearch


Use this wordsearch to help your child become familiar with terms and words relating to being online.
